## **SOLOISTS – Vocal or Instrumental**

Know your music before you come to rehearse. Be prepared to make changes as required.

Schedule a rehearsal with Floyd or Sue by Thursday at least the week before the Sunday you are scheduled to participate. More rehearsals are fine.

Ensure that the Music Director attends your rehearsal the week before the Sunday you are scheduled to participate. If you rehearse with Floyd that will probably be on Thursday.

No soloists will participate on Sunday if they have not rehearsed and been vetted by the Music Director by the Thursday before the Sunday they are scheduled to participate.

Our goal is to present the best possible music to the Lord on Sunday. If we rehearse hard and it does not go well, God knows the effort that we expended to bring Him the best. If we do not rehearse and it does not go well, God also knows that we gave Him only a taste of our best effort. He gave us His all, we should try to do the same.
